



Wellness Blood work Consent Form

It is very important for the health of your pet to get a comprehensive blood work panel at least once a year, just like your doctor does for you. This allows us to screen for common physical conditions and abnormalities that can affect pets as they age *that cannot and/or may not be evident* on your pets physical examination. Remember they can't tell us something seems wrong. **A yearly blood test for heartworm prevention and a fecal is required with your annual,** a few more drops will tell us so much more.

The following conditions are examples of **SERIOUS CONDITIONS** that your pet can be screened for by allowing the yearly wellness blood work:

*Liver Disease *Kidney Disease *Diabetes *Anemia *Infection *Cushing's Disease	*Thyroid disease *Long term medication usage on internal organs (ie arthritis medication, steroids, allergy medications etc) *Pancreatic disease *Protein loss
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The key to a longer healthier quality of life for your pet is early detection and/or early intervention in therapy for these disease related conditions.

Our doctors firmly believe in a good physical examination *externally as well as internally* for your pet.

******If a urine sample is not collected at the time of the visit, there is a 30 day time frame from this exam to bring it in to send to the laboratory at no additional cost .***

The options for bloodwork vary depending on the age of your pet and their breed. Please review the options on reference guide and if the doctor feels your pet is at risk and should get something more they will let you know.
